

RAFFLE RULES

MAY 2021

1. Raffles should be conducted fairly
2. Raffle organisers can buy tickets but cannot win prizes – if they win a prize the prize should be redrawn
3. For every \$100 of tickets sold, a minimum of \$40 is kept by the Club and \$60 is “paid out” in prizes
For simplicity, use the 50/50 rule – for every \$100 of tickets sold, \$50 goes to the Club and \$50 goes in prizes
4. Raffles can be run with a total prize value of up to \$30,000
5. The maximum that can be paid in cash is \$7,000
The less cash paid out in prizes the better
6. Up to 20 litres of alcohol can be won in prizes when the alcohol content is up to 20%
Up to 5 litres of alcohol can be won in prizes when the alcohol content is more than 20%
7. Children can participate – provided they are legally in the Club according to the laws regarding minors
8. Tickets should include the price and the name of the Club
9. Any Club rules in relation to raffles, eg joker jackpot, should be announced or indicated where they are displayed before a raffle is drawn
10. Keep records of date, gross proceeds, total prizes and where practicable, names of prize winners
